5. Mr. Peter Lim

Another position vacant is the Vice Presidency post vacated by YBhg Dato' Mohd Aini Hj. Taib who resigned in September as he had his hands full with his other pet projects. By the dateline of 29 November 2009, YBhg Dato

Syed Mustaffa was returned unopposed. Mr. Robert Lau from Sarawak was the only nominee for the Vice President post whereas only three nominations were received for the three Management Committee's vacancies, namely Mr. Peter Chee, Mr. Leslie Ponnampalam and Mr. K. Sivanesen. SRAM has come a long way from its tumultuous year of the 2007 AGM where every vacancy was keenly contested and supporters were brought in by the bus-loads. For the 2009 AGM, all nominees simply walked into their positions and we also have one Vice Presidency post available which the President may use to appoint and groom a potential candidate for the top post.


III. AGM's Proceeding



With the election result a foregone conclusion, it was time to put the Deputy President in the limelight. In his Annual Report, YBhg Dato' Syed mentioned the achievements to show that SRAM was on the right track to achieve its vision of putting Malaysia as 'A Powerhouse in World Squash', pointing to the Clean Sweep by Malaysia in the 2009 Asian Junior Championship, including the ASF Presidency won by Dato' Sani himself.

En. Amran was then given the opportunity to present the proposed SRAM Constitution Ammendments. After much deliberation by the members on the inclusion of some new clauses in the draft, the Chairman passed a resolution that an EGM shall be convened to further deliberate the matter.

The unsuccessful Olympic 2016 bid did not go to waste as it showcased the major roles played by Malaysia in the bidding process. Even our Squash 2016 Day Celebration was recognised as among the best in the world. True to the maxim of MALAYSIA BOLEH, the par excellence organisation of the 2009 World Squash Federation AGM at the Holiday Villa, Subang Jaya on the 13 – 14 November had all the delegates from 46 member countries in awe and battle-ready for the post-Olympic era of squash.
